

Moving Averages

- Mathematical average calculated from a certain amount of past data points
- Two Types
 - Simple Moving Average (SMA)
 - Exponential Moving Average (EMA): Increased weight on more recent data
- Strategies
 - Crossover of Asset
 - Crossover of Two Moving Averages
 - Bullish Crossover
 - Bearish Crossover
- Disadvantages
 - Lagging Indicator
 - Shaky Success in Volatile Industries
 - “Market has no Memory” Ideology

Candlestick Patterns

- Head and Shoulders
 - Possible significance of trend reversal
 - HS-Top/HS-Bottom
- Double Top/Bottom
 - Reversal Pattern
 - Prices potentially lost their rally

Trendlines

- Used to identify uptrends/downtrends
- The more points of confirmation, more validity of trendline
- Types
 - Support Lines
 - Resistance Lines
 - Channels

Moving Average Convergence/Divergence (MACD)

- Portrays relationship between two moving averages
- Three Components
 - MACD Line
 - Signal Line
 - Baseline
- Strategies
 - Crossovers
 - Divergences
 - Rapid Movements
